

#### **About ERCF**

The Eye Research Centre Foundation (ERCF), established in 1978 in Chennai, is a nonprofit committed to eliminating avoidable blindness through high-impact community outreach, advanced ophthalmic care, and pioneering research. In partnership with Dr. Agarwal's Eye Hospital, ERCF conducts over 60–70 free screening camps monthly across Tamil Nadu, performs 700–800 free surgeries, and supports patients with transportation, food, and accommodation. It also leads school vision programs, urban eye care initiatives, and training for eye care professionals, all while promoting inclusivity, accountability, and innovation in eye health.





# Our Collaboration with Government



During the year, our Foundation continued to expand its reach across Tamil Nadu by conducting free eye screening and surgical camps in 11 districts – Chennai, Chengalpattu, Kanchipuram, Thiruvallur, Vellore, Ranipet, Tiruppattur, Tiruvannamalai, Tirunelveli, Tuticorin, and Tenkasi.

These camps were organized under a formal partnership with the Government of Tamil Nadu through signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with the District Blindness Control Societies (DBCS) in each of these districts. This collaboration has enabled us to align our efforts with the National Programme for Control of Blindness and Visual Impairment (NPCBVI), ensuring that our interventions directly contribute to the state's goal of eliminating avoidable blindness.

# Student Engagement in Community Eye Health

In 2024, students of Dr. Agarwals Institute of Optometry actively integrated community outreach into their learning, creating meaningful public impact.

On World Optometry Day, they conducted an awareness campaign that dispelled myths about the role of optometrists and educated citizens on preventive eye care.





In August 2024, through school vision screenings across North Chennai, they reached 2,470 children in 15 government and aided schools with eye checks and hygiene awareness. Marking World Sight Day 2024, students extended their services to 400 children across 12 child care homes in Chennai, blending clinical screenings with interactive, child-friendly activities.

Together, these initiatives reinforced the institute's commitment to nurturing socially responsible professionals while advancing community eye health.

### Stories of Hope



#### Mr. Nadarasan is a hardworking man from a small village in

**Chengalpattu,** Tamil Nadu. He spent many years as a farmer, working under the sun to feed his family. But when farming could no longer support them, he took up a new job — painting houses.

Nadarasan was proud of his work. Painting needed focus, balance, and most of all, clear vision. But slowly, cataract began to affect his eyes. His vision became blurry. He struggled to paint neatly, and even riding his two-wheeler became dangerous.

Losing his vision affected everything. He lost confidence, couldn't work properly, and felt helpless about providing for his family.

That's when the Eye Research Centre Foundation stepped in to help.

Through our outreach program, Nadarasan received free cataract surgery.

The treatment changed his life. His vision became clear again, and his world became bright once more.

Today, Nadarasan is back to painting homes with confidence and care.

He is independent again and able to support his loved ones. For Nadarasan, this was not just a medical treatment — it was a true miracle. A miracle that brought back his vision, his work, and his dignity.



**Priya, a lively 3-year-old from Chennai,** loved going to school but found herself falling behind. The blackboard looked blurred, reading was a struggle, and even playing outside felt unsafe. Slowly, her cheerful spirit began to fade. Her parents, both daily wage earners, noticed her difficulty but felt helpless — advanced eye treatment was far beyond their means.

During one of our outreach camps, Priya was diagnosed with congenital cataract and brought to our base hospital in Chennai. There, she underwent free paediatric cataract surgery.

The moment Priya's bandages were removed was unforgettable — she smiled, looked around the room with wonder, and clutched her mother's hand tightly. Her world was bright again.

Today, Priya is back in school, reading confidently, playing happily, and dreaming fearlessly about her future. For her family, it was not just surgery — it was the return of their daughter's joy and potential.

## **Our Impact**

**Empowering Vision, Enabling Learning for School Children** 



As part of our commitment to child well-being and inclusive education, the Eye Research Centre Foundation (ERCF) conducted comprehensive eye screenings across schools in Chennai, Vellore and Tiruvannamalai Districts of Tamil Nadu.

The program focused on early detection of refractive errors—a leading but often overlooked barrier to academic performance. Children diagnosed with vision issues were provided free spectacles, effectively removing a significant obstacle to their education.
